This time around, we decided to supply several villages (300 to 700 people per village) with bags of corn and bean seeds so that they could sow and reap the work of their hands thus making them less dependable on outside help. Many of the locals have been on the verge of starvation for the last few years and were overjoyed to receive the bags filled with seeds. Excited and hopeful, they set out to work on their gardens, hoping to feed their families as their hard labor pays off. A seed... such a small thing yet it can prevent a family from despairing of life. Not only have they received a bag that will produce rows of corn or tall beanstalks, but they have also been given a seed of faith. Just like the physical seed, if well taken care of, this one will sprout and eventually give birth to a new life in Jesus Christ. This is how the kingdom of heaven grows and spreads all across

the world. God's people sow one seed at a time, then someone else comes along and waters.

We are so thankful to you, our dear friends and partners in ministry, for joining us in this process of sowing! Whether you pray, give, or go, you are part of what's happening in Uganda right now. We are anxious to see the harvest – physical and spiritual – as God gives growth to both. As we approach Christmas time, let's be reminded that both our hands and hearts are full because of what Jesus has done for us. Someone planted a seed in our lives, and it sprang up to produce much beauty and eternal hope. It's our turn to keep planting, to keep watering, to keep loving, to keep forgiving, to keep tending to the tender shoots. There's no better business to be in than to be employed by the Master Gardener who is with us every step of the way and who so tenderly loves us at every stage of our own growth.
